

### **2011-2012 MEAL PRICES**

Breakfast and lunch is available each school day at the following rates:

Elementary Lunch	\$2.10 (Paid)	.40 (Reduced)	\$ 2.85 (Adult)

### **ELEMENTARY MEAL CHARGE POLICY**

Meal charging is not encouraged but we understand may be necessary on occasion at the elementary level. Elementary students may be permitted to charge up to three days. After three days of meal charges, students arriving at school without payment or a meal from home will be served a sandwich and milk at a cost of .75 for lunch or graham crackers and milk for breakfast at a cost of .30 per day. Reminder notes will be sent home daily with students who have a negative balance. All meal charges must be repaid in full.

Please contact the cafeteria manager directly if a student has special circumstances (dietary, financial, etc.) that should be taken into consideration.

### **SECONDARY MEAL CHARGE POLICY**

Middle school or high school students are not allowed to charge meals on a regular basis. Occasionally, a student may be permitted to charge one meal by requesting permission directly from the cafeteria manager prior to proceeding through the cafeteria line. If a student already has a negative balance, no additional charges will be allowed. All meal charges must be repaid in full. No ala-carte items may be charged.

If a middle school or high school student chooses to go through the line without money on account or without permission from the manager, they will be given the following options:

- Pay for meal and/or on account at that time
- Borrow money from someone (friend, school fund, etc.)
- Ask a friend to put the meal on their account (must be in line together)
- Return the tray to the cashier

Students can check meal account balances with any cashier before they go through the line.
